Dr. Rex Bernardo is Professor and Endowed Chair in Corn Breeding and Genetics. He obtained his undergraduate degree in the Philippines in 1984 and his Ph.D. degree in plant breeding from the University of Illinois in the USA in 1988. Dr. Bernardo developed the widely used GBLUP procedure in 1994, and most of his work has focused on marker-assisted breeding. Dr. Bernardo is Director of the Plant Breeding Center at Minnesota, has written two textbooks, and teaches graduate courses in plant breeding and in professional skills for scientists.
